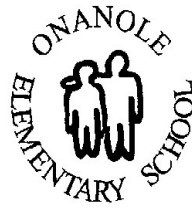

With December just around the corner we have loaded up our book shelf with lots of great Christmas books. There are also new stories at Listen to Read. Over the next few weeks the students will be busy learning the words to all the songs for our Christmas Concert "Santa Goes Green".

Last week the class did some mixing of solids and liquids as part of our Science unit. The students wanted to share the recipe for

"gumdrops" so here it is:

50ml grape or apple juice

Package of unflavored gelatin

Sugar

Wax paper

Heat 50 ml of juice in a pot until it boils. Remove from the stove and add one package of gelatin to the liquid. Stir until completely dissolved. Spoon the mixture onto wax paper in quarter-sized blobs. Let cool about a minute and then sprinkle with sugar. Then cool about ten more minutes.

This week we will be doing some experiments about "air".

It was nice to see parents last week. Thank you for coming in and supporting your child's learning.

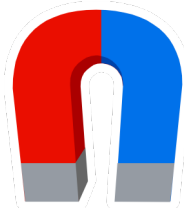
