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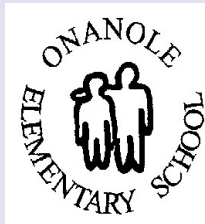

The playground is going to be pretty wet this week. An extra pair of socks might be a good idea.

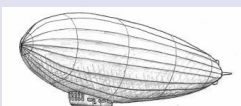
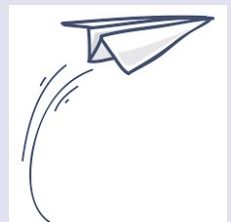
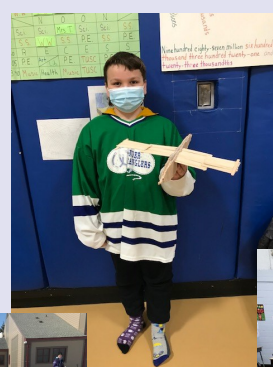
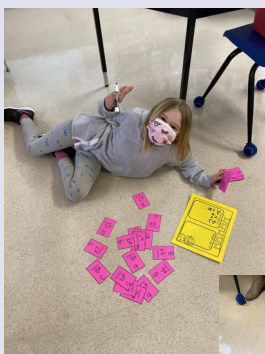
